



Roller fairleads, control tow lines when retrieving net at start

Outrigger to hold top of net up so fish don't jump over the cork line

"Wishbone" stabilizes mast and can rig a shelter

Big Crew!!
Nine men to work the gear.

Fish baskets, mostly empty.

"Corkline" at top of net (plastic corks)

Basket boat, used to help with net and lines

The last of the net—with fish??

Tow lines—draw the ends of the net together to capture the fish—coiled down.

Running Home, big heap of net on deck



SEINER JUST FINISHING "DRYING OUT" THE NET. The white floats keep the top of the net at the surface, weights on the hem keep it down, making a long wall in the water. The boat runs in a circle to lay out the net and bring the two ends together then pulls it all back aboard by hand, hopefully with the fish all crowded together at the end.
